The 1951 Ford F-1 Panel Truck from Custom Model Depot is an accurate representation of the prototype, scaled to actual dimensions.

The basic requirements for building the kit are 400 grit sandpaper, cyanoacrylate glue (super glue), an Xacto Blade, and Gloss Mod Podge. Using gloss Mod Podge, dilute with water to a water like mixture. With a small brush, apply the mixture to the edge of the opening. Next, with tweezers, place the window into the opening. Release the window from the tweezers and let the window glazing settle into the opening. The water tension of the mixture will mostly position the window glazing. You can move the glazing around with a damp brush to position the glazing and remove extra glue.
